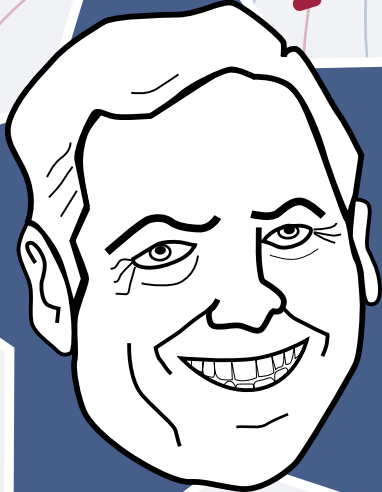

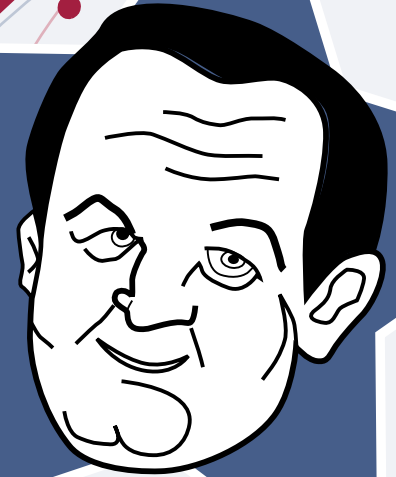

The Michigan Political Leadership Program (MPLP) at Michigan State University (MSU) is a bi-partisan fellowship program designed for those committed to greater involvement in the public policy process, particularly while seeking elected office.

MPLP is distinguished as one of only a handful of programs of its kind in the nation. Since its 1992 inception, nearly 350 MPLP fellows have received scholarships to participate in a 10-weekend curriculum. Well over 100 of the program graduates have gone on to hold elected office and undertaken leadership positions.

Each year well over 1,000 Michigan residents attend fundraising events held in the Detroit area and Grand Rapids. Contributed funds support the 24 annual fellowships awarded to aspiring policy leaders.

MPLP is a program of the Institute for Public Policy and Social Research (IPPSR) in MSU's College of Social Science.
