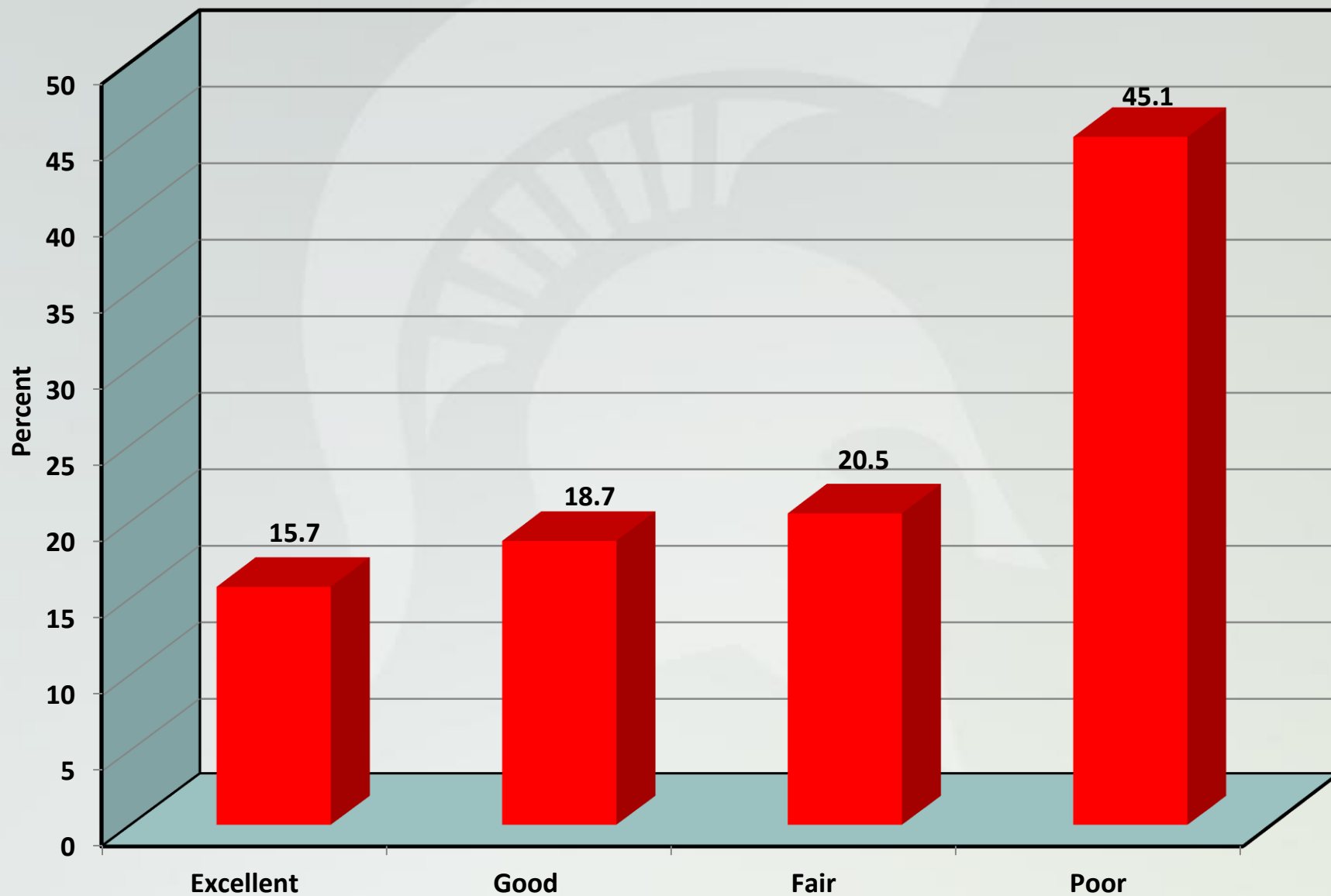

President Trump's favorable ratings continued to edge upward. He received ratings of "excellent" or "good" from 34.4% of Michigan residents. That compares with 31.5% in the previous survey.



Michigan Residents' Ratings of President Trump's Performance, Fall 2018



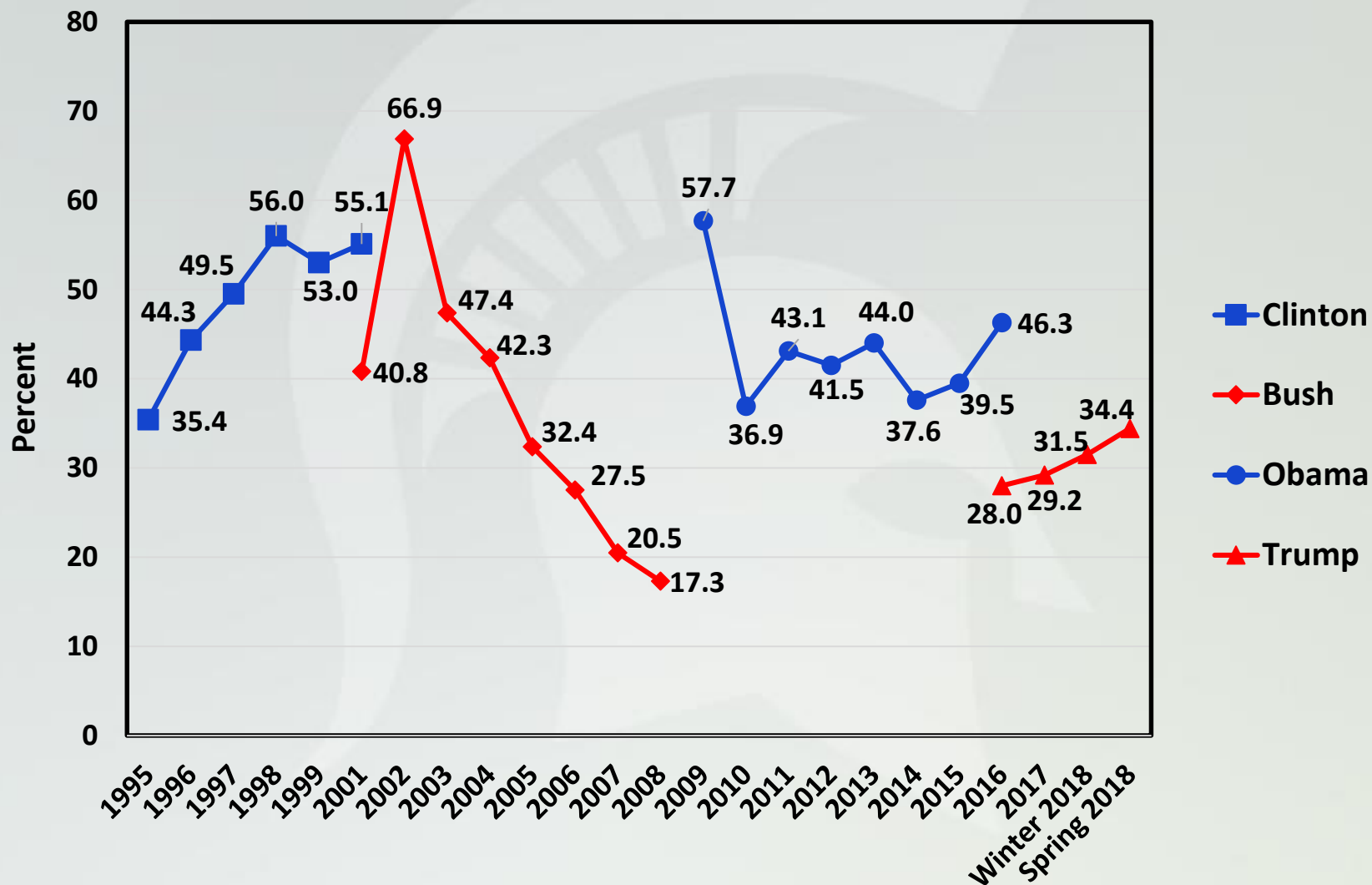


These are the most favorable ratings ever for Trump.

Despite the improvement, however, Trump's ratings remained lower than Clinton or Obama ever received, but higher than George W. Bush received in his second term.



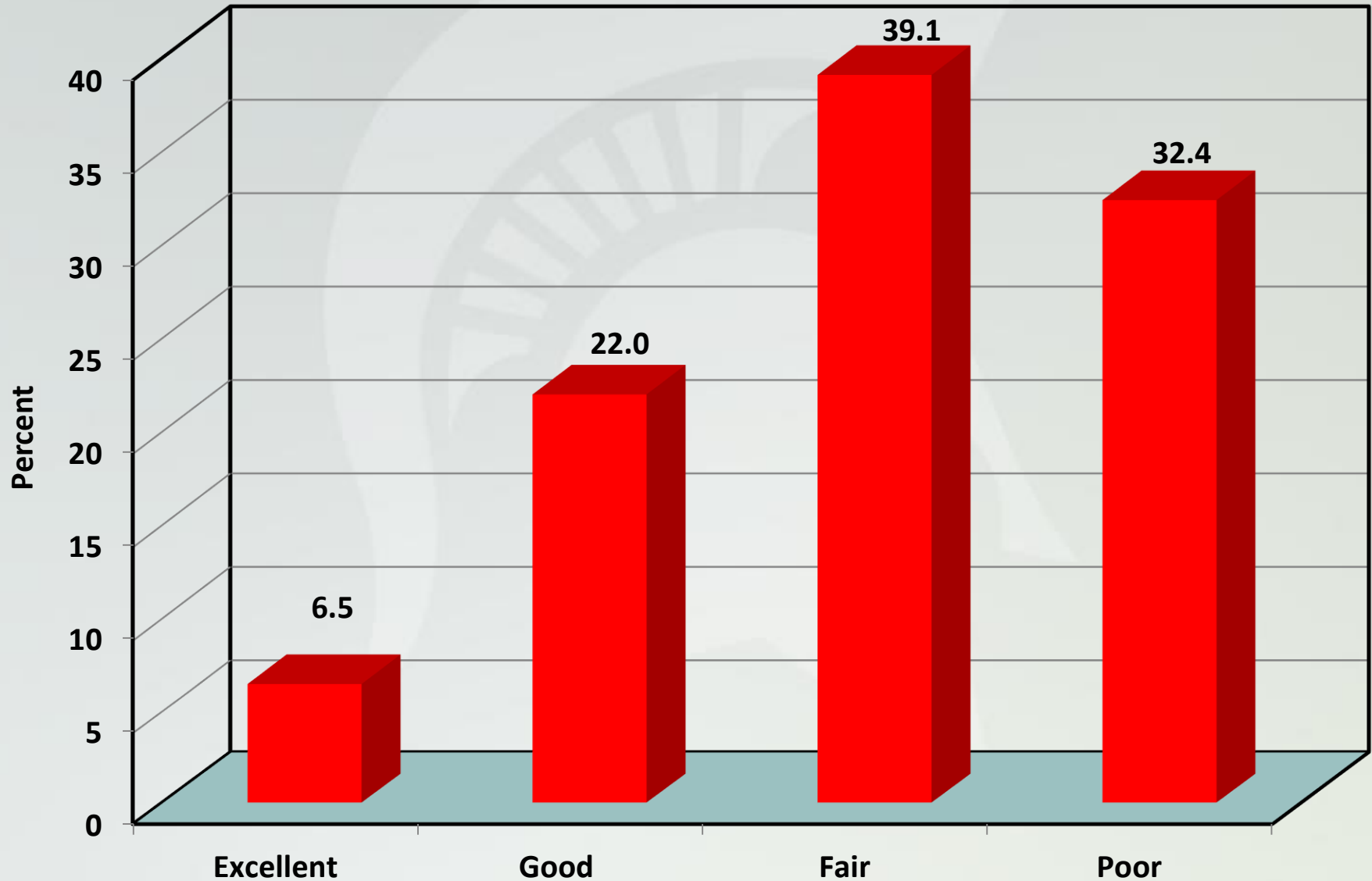
Percentage of Michigan Residents Rating U.S. President's Performance as "Excellent" or "Good", 1995-2018





Governor Snyder's favorable ratings dipped slightly, with 28.5% giving him a rating of "excellent" or "good."

Michigan Residents' Ratings of Governor Snyder's Performance, Fall 2018



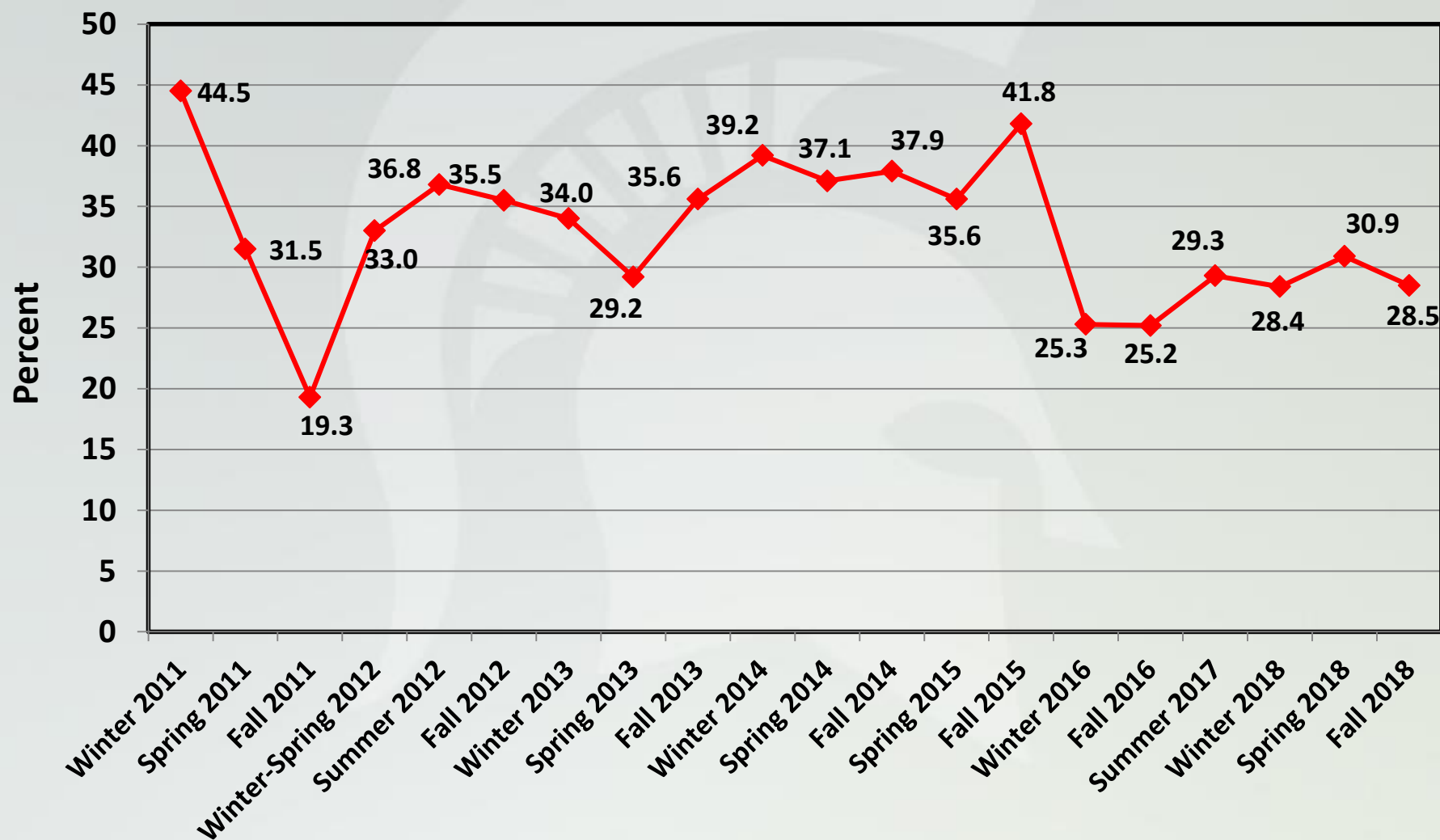


Former Governors Engler and Granholm had their lowest ratings in the last round of State of the State Survey before they left office.

Governor Snyder has avoided that fate. His last set of ratings are well below his best, but also not his worst.

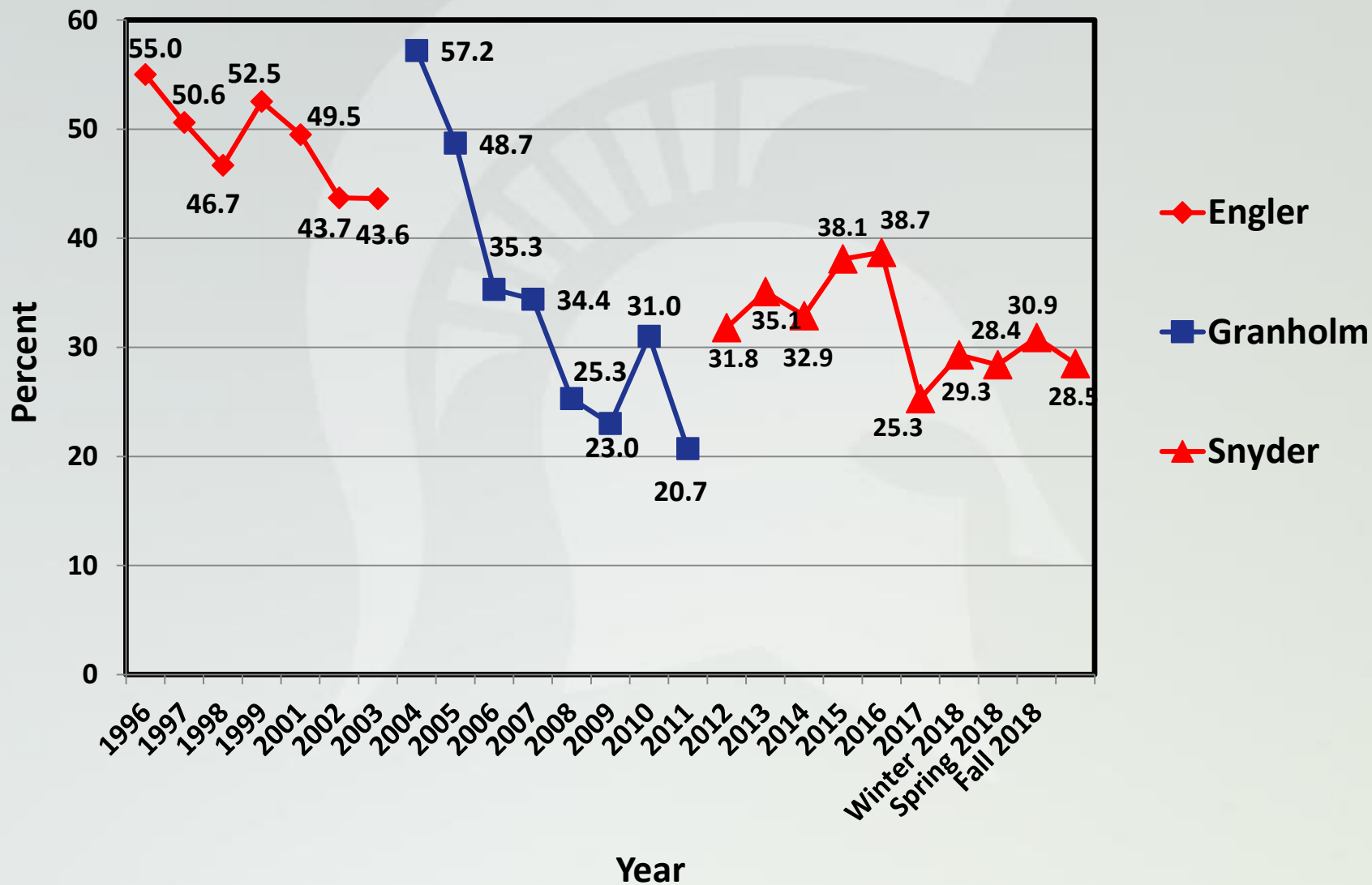


Percentage of Michigan Residents Rating Governor Snyder's Performance as "Excellent" or "Good", 2011-2018





Percentage of Michigan Residents Rating Performance of Governors as "Excellent" or "Good," 1995-2018



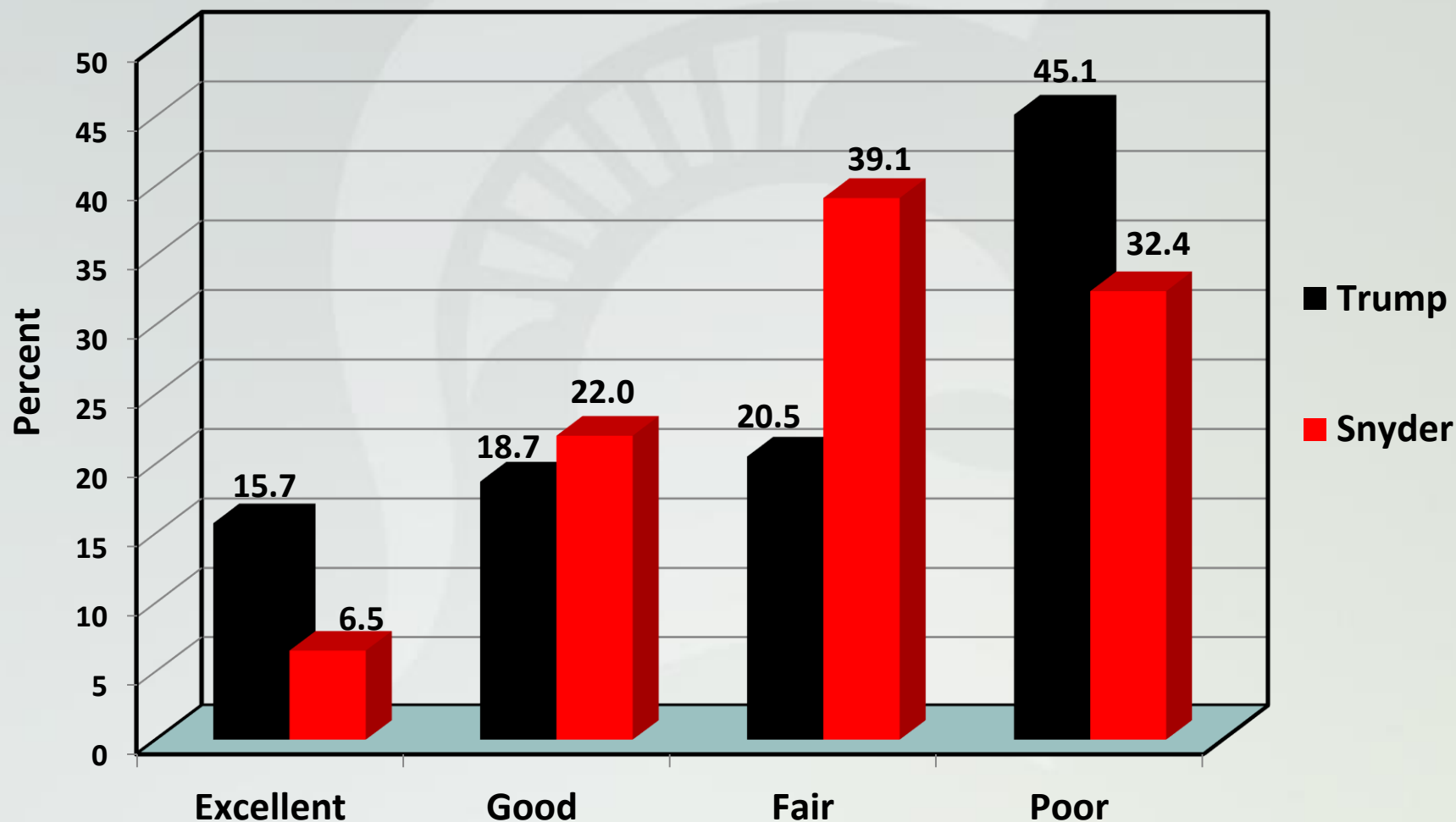


President Trump evokes more extreme responses than Governor Snyder:

Trump has a higher percentage of “excellent” ratings, but also a higher percentage of “poor” ratings.

When we look beneath the statewide averages, the ratings for Trump and Snyder reveal stark differences in attitudes, by race, sex, party affiliation, and region.

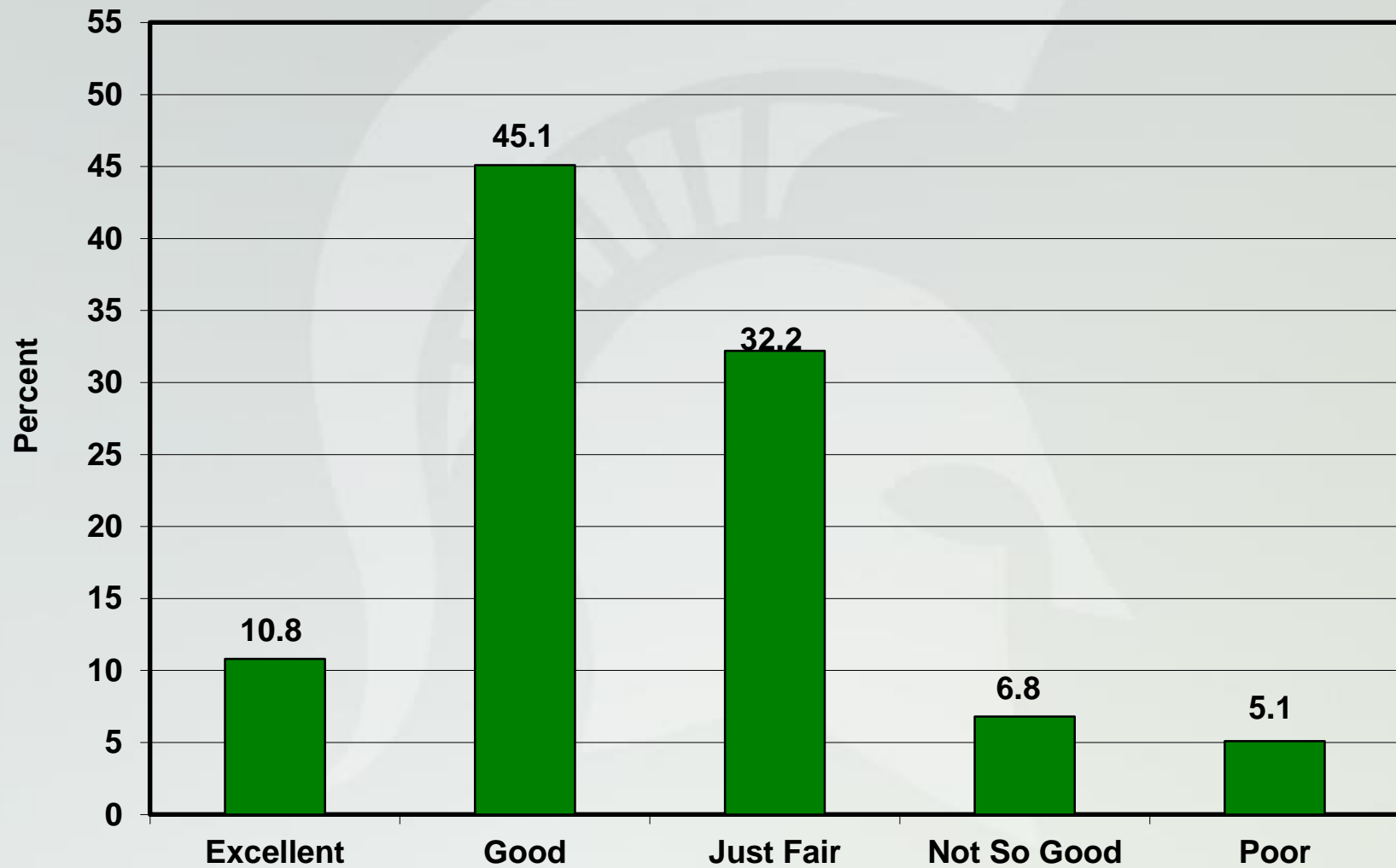


The fraction of Michigan residents who say their current financial situation is “excellent” or “good” dropped a bit, but remained strong by historical standards.

Assessments of the current financial situation remained slightly below the all-time highs, set in the late 1990s and early 2000s.

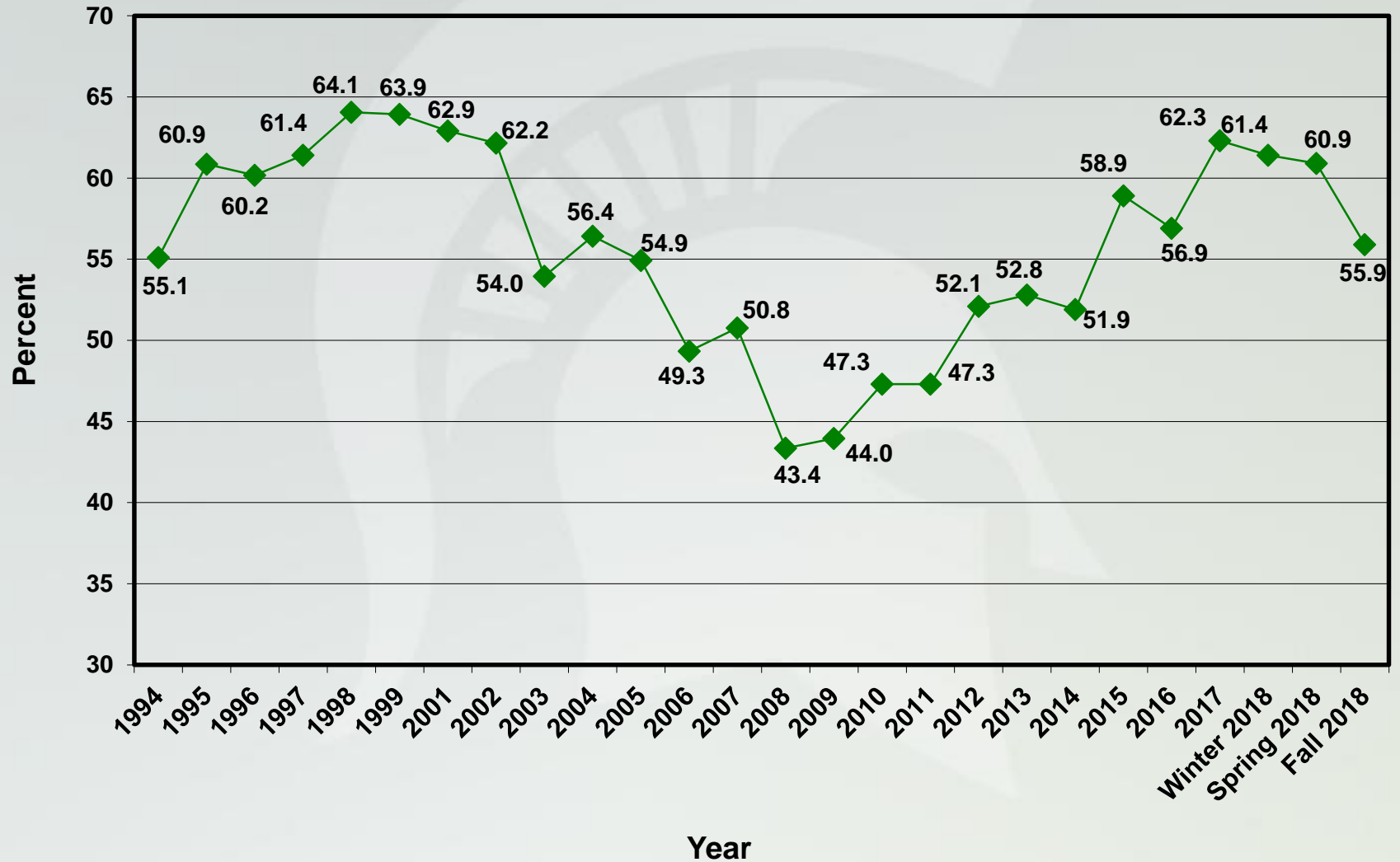


Michigan Residents' Assessments of Their Current Financial Situation, Fall 2018

"Excellent" or "Good", 1994-2018

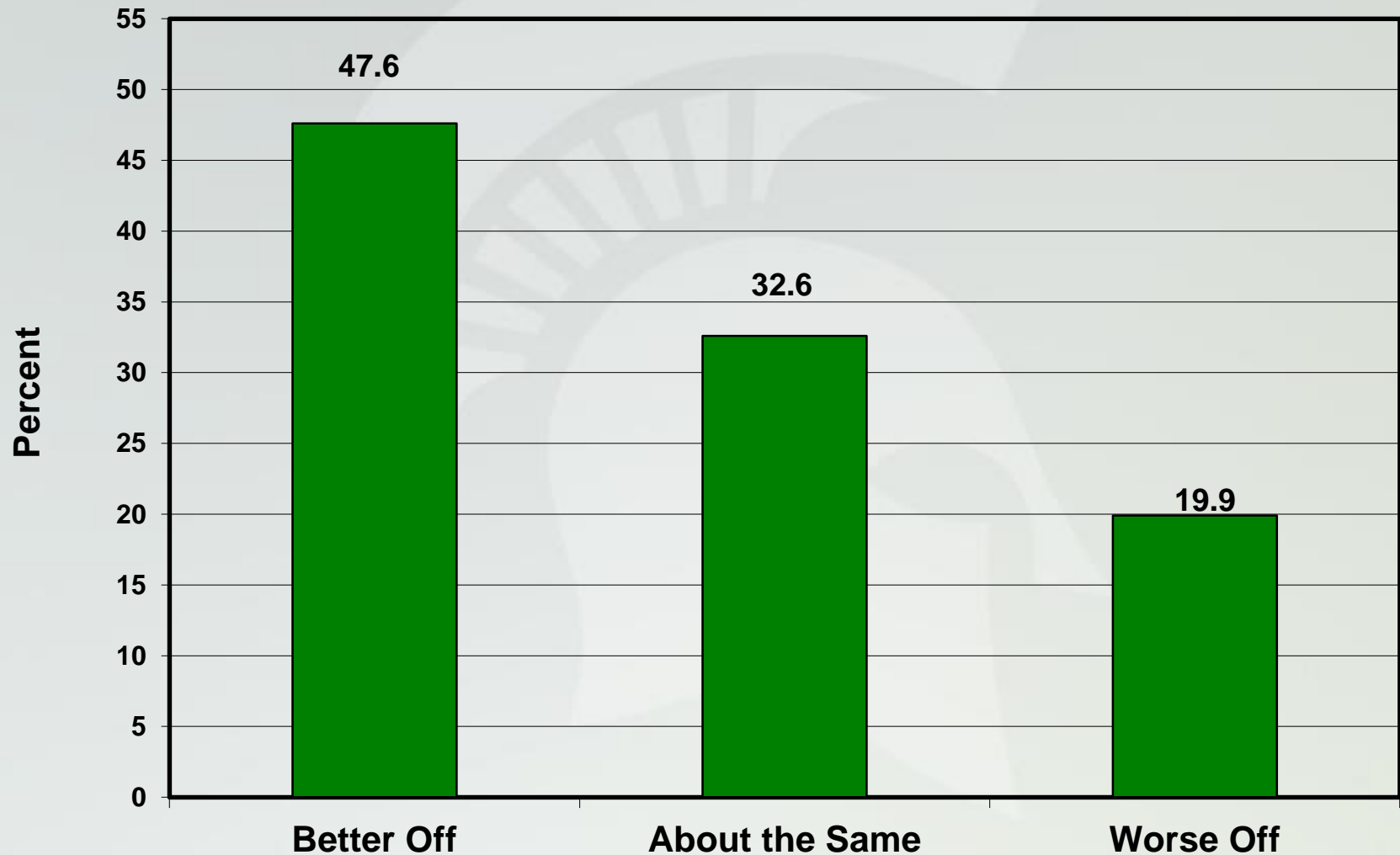

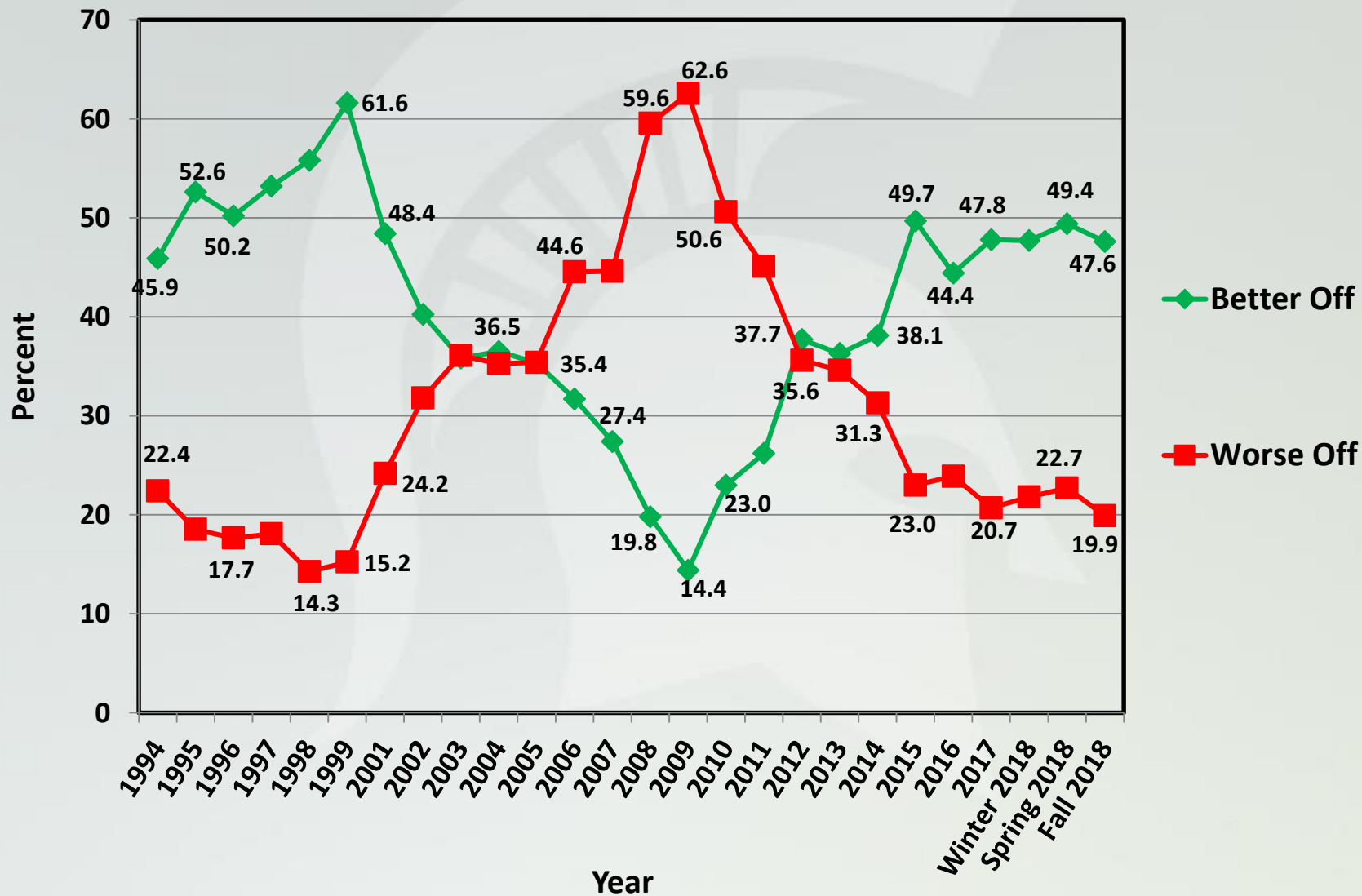


Michigan Residents' Beliefs About Whether They Are Better Off Than One Year Ago, Fall 2018





Michigan Residents' Beliefs About Whether They Are Better Off or Worse Off Than One Year Ago, 1995-2018

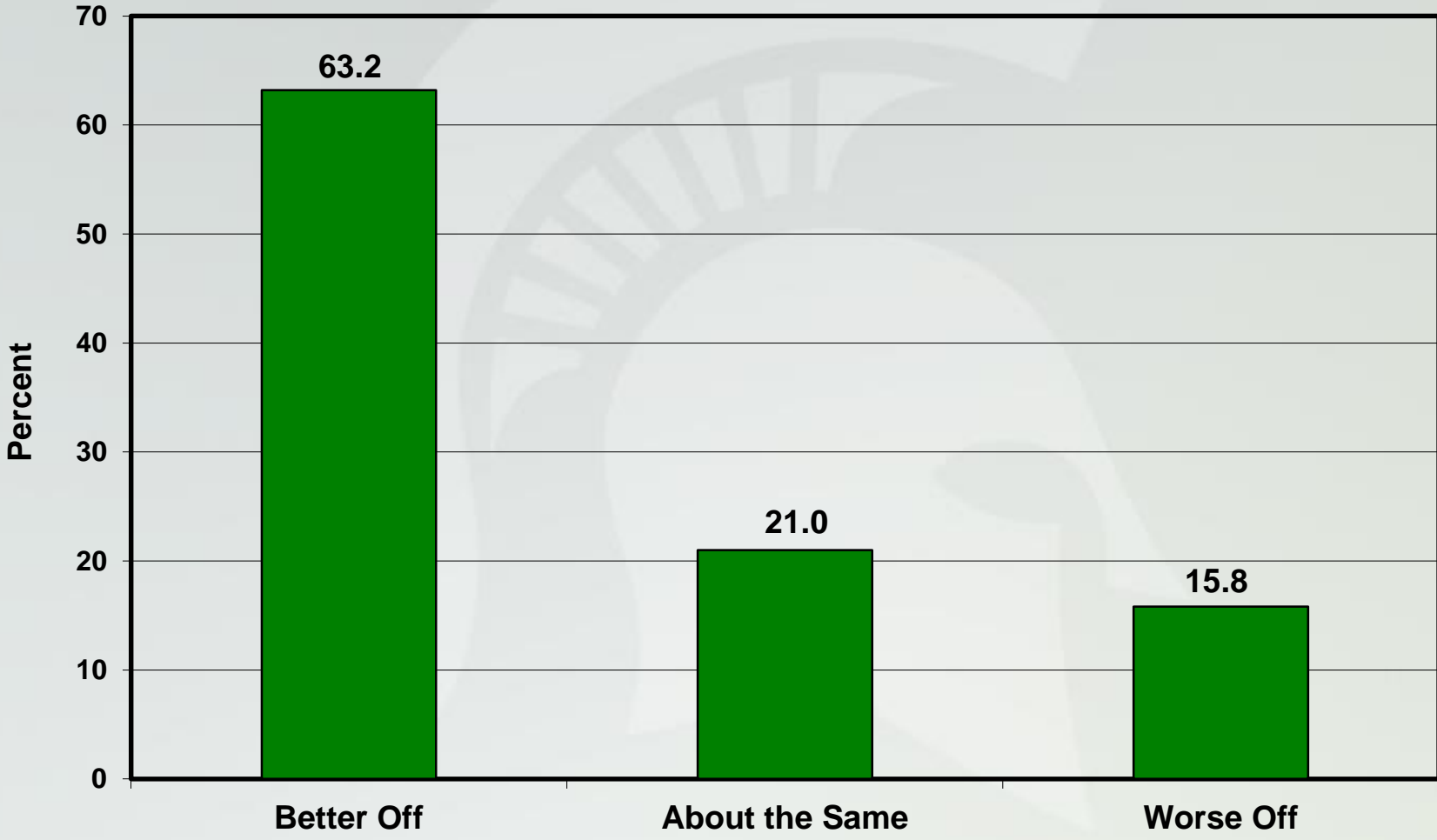




Michigan residents' assessment of whether they will be *better off one year from now* was also one of the best in more than a decade.

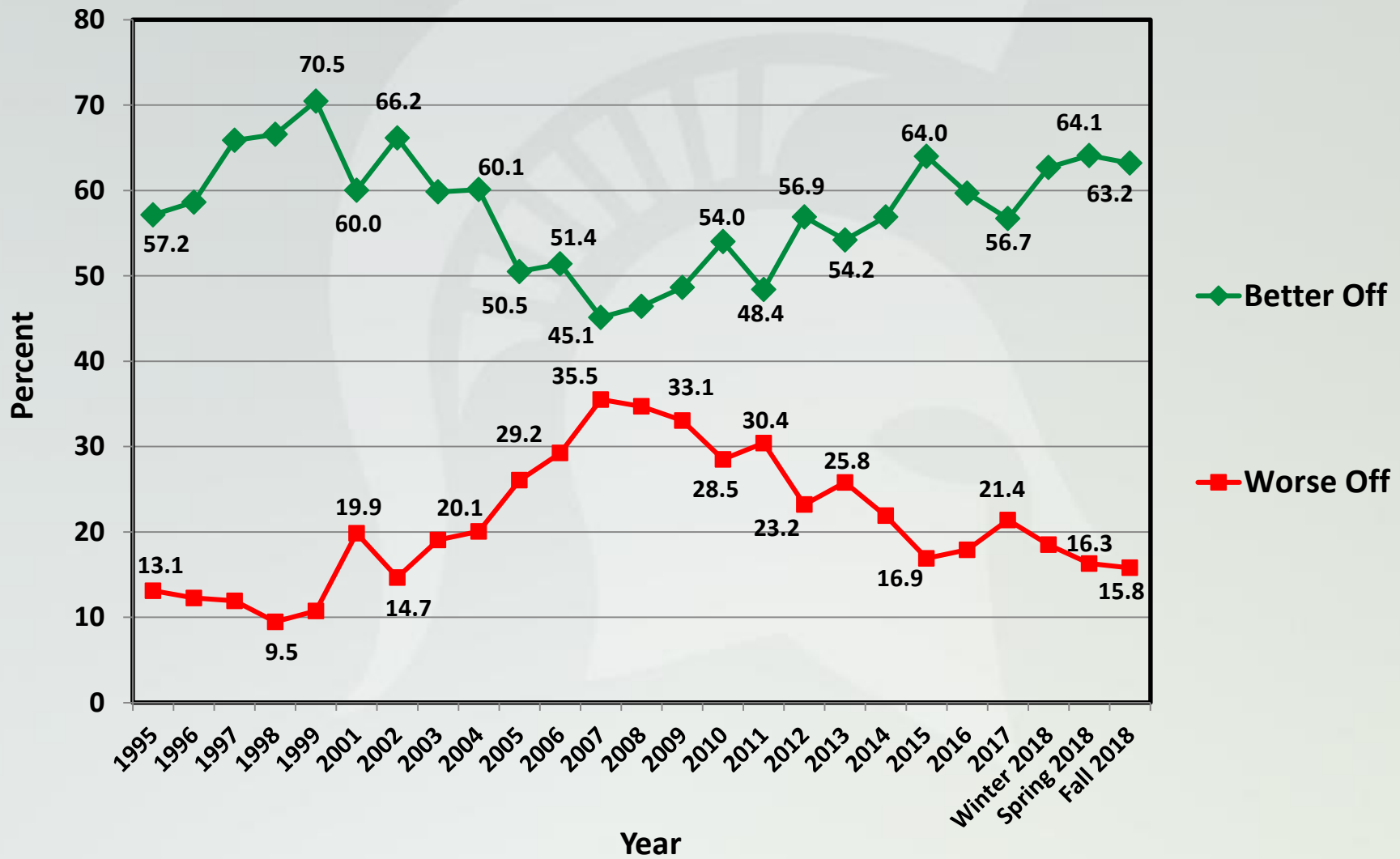


Michigan Residents' Beliefs About Whether They Will Be Better Off One Year From Now, Fall 2018

For all three of these measures of consumer confidence, the ratings are much better than in 2006-2011, but still lower than in 1999.
